All the below programs require students going through their program to continue on with their college degree.

Pillar College (Through TTI) 718-376-0974 extension 0

Nachlas Bais Yaakov is one of the few select seminaries that have been offered a chance to join a Study Abroad Program. Through an affiliation with Pillar College and Testing and Training International (TTI), financially eligible students from New Jersey will be able to receive up to \$17,000 towards seminary tuition.

As part of the program, students will be earning a Bachelor's degree in Biblical Studies from Pillar College, which is more aligned with the seminary experience. The additional courses to complete the Bachelor's degree (beyond the seminary year) will be created and taught by mechanchos from within our community. Even those not eligible for financial aid, can still take advantage of the Bachelor's degree opportunity.

Please contact TTI directly to get started by filling out the FAFSA application. This is the first step that needs to be completed at this time, and they can provide



some direction.

**Please be aware that the tuition assistance process is the responsibility of parents, not the seminary. The seminary invested much time, effort and research to be recognized by these institutions; however, the obligation to sign up one's daughter to these programs is strictly the parents'. It is therefore incumbent on you to file and oversee the tuition assistance process, where time is of utmost importance. The sooner you apply, the more of a chance you have in receiving the funding from these institutions.



Medical Insurance

It is our sincere hope that all our תלמידות will remain healthy throughout the coming year. Nevertheless, it is important that we provide the best medical coverage possible in case of need.

Aim Insurance is the preeminent insurance provider in Eretz Yisrael for overseas students. They have the ability to assist the client, even in the most trying situations. **It is compulsory for every student to be signed up with Aim Insurance. NO girl will be allowed into the dormitory without Aim coverage.** You will be receiving a package directly from them. Please respond in a timely manner.

Dresscode

Being a student at יעקב בית נחלת carries with it certain obligations and responsibilities. It is important for you to know that נחלת בית יעקב abides by the standards set by גדולי ישראל in ארץ ישראל, which follow a certain הנהגה that is suitable to the ירושלים עיר הקודש of קדושה.

Nachlas Uniform:

- **Shirts** – button down, long sleeved shirt with a collar in a solid, light color only.
- **Skirts** – standard uniform fabric, pleated, at least 4 inches below the knee (no lycra, stretch fabric permitted). This skirt length goes for all times, Shabbos and weekday, in school and out.
- **Sweaters** – Black, navy, or dark gray solid sweaters, or sleeveless vest.

More detailed dress codes & policies will be sent in future mailings.

Technology

Only MP3 players and recording devices without screens and internet capabilities are allowed. It is forbidden to have any other device (Ipod, Ipad, MP4, Laptop, etc.) which has a screen for viewing and internet or email connections even if those capabilities were removed. Any music or shiurim you would like, should be transferred BEFORE you arrive.

Cell Phones

Only kosher cell phones with the מאושר symbol from the ועד הרבנים of ארץ ישראל or the Escolls אני חומה phone are allowed. Non-kosher phones of any kind are forbidden.

All other phones that are brought along or acquired in ארץ ישראל must be deposited



in the school's safe for the year.

Due to security and safety considerations, we require each student to have a נחלת בית יעקב cellular phone while in seminary. In order to maximize the full value of the cell phones, it is imperative that all our students and supervisory staff be on one network. This will allow us to interface smoothly by contacting the entire student body instantaneously, thereby quickly accounting for the whereabouts of each student when necessary. This is crucial to our supervision and your peace of mind. You will be receiving a mailing packet in the summer directly from our provider.

CONSENT AND RELEASE

To: *Nachlas Bais Yaakov – Jerusalem:*

I, _____, the parent or legal guardian of _____ of _____ (address) (the "Student") do hereby declare and undertake as follows:

1. With my consent and approval, the Student has applied to study at Nachlas Bais Yaakov – Jerusalem (the "Seminary") in the upcoming academic year.
2. I am aware that the Student shall be entitled to withdraw her registration with the Seminary by delivering written notice to the Seminary no later than April 1st, 2026 and, in the event of such withdrawal, any registration fee shall be refunded after deduction of the non-refundable deposit of \$7,900. After such date, no amounts shall be refunded and any deferred payments shall be collected on their due dates.
3. I HEREBY ACKNOWLEDGE AND DECLARE THAT THE STUDENT, IF ACCEPTED, SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE TO COMPLY WITH ALL REGULATIONS AND STANDARDS OF CONDUCT ESTABLISHED BY YOU FROM TIME TO TIME. I am aware that any failure to comply with said regulations and standards (including timely payment of tuition) may lead to the Student being required to leave the Seminary or continue her studies subject to restrictions. In the event of termination of the Student's participation in the Seminary program, I shall be solely responsible for arranging for the Student's return home and neither I nor the Student shall be entitled to any compensation and/or refund of fees or other payments made in relation to her participation in the Seminary program.
4. I hereby confirm that the Student has been examined by a suitably qualified physician who has been presented with all relevant information concerning the Student's medical history and proposed participation in the Seminary program. Said physician has confirmed that the Student is in good health and that there is no reason to believe that the Student should not participate in the program and/or travel overseas. The Student does not suffer from any physical, emotional or mental condition. Withholding any information from the seminary regarding physical, emotional or mental conditions of the Student could be grounds for dismissal.
5. I hereby authorize and direct the Seminary and its' authorized representatives to procure for the Student any medical or other assistance that may be required.
In case of what the SEMINARY deems medical necessity, i.e. hospital care, and or serious medical care beyond the normal care the seminary can offer, the seminary has a right to require parental assistance, that is, parents coming in from abroad to take care of the student, in case there is no family assistance available in Eretz Yisroel.
6. I hereby agree to hold the Seminary, its' directors, agents, employees and assigns harmless from any liability or other obligation for any loss or other damage to any personal property of the Student or from other liability arising from the Seminary's acting in accordance with the above provisions.
7. I acknowledge that I have had the opportunity to receive advice regarding the contents of this document and fully understand its' provisions and implications. I am aware that the Seminary is only prepared to consider the Student's application in reliance upon my declarations and undertakings in this Consent and Release.
8. In order to make this document Halachically binding, we add the following:
